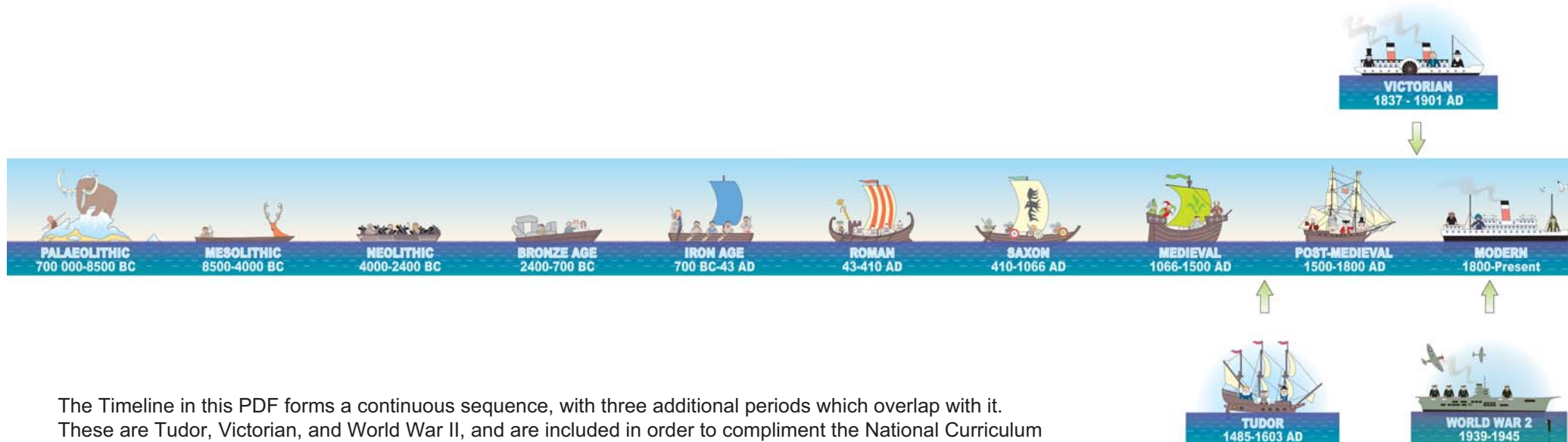

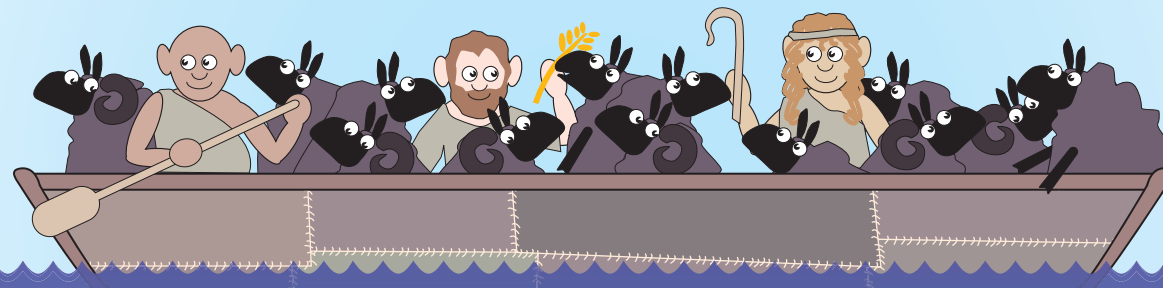

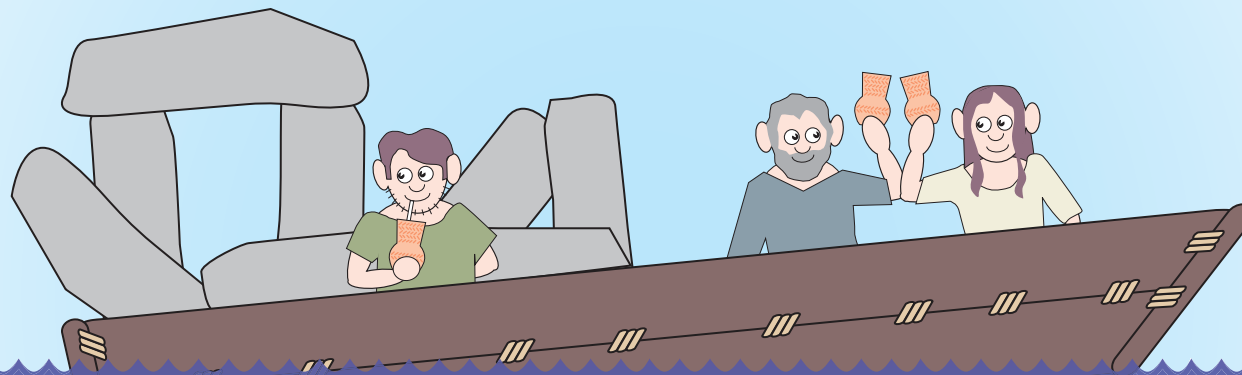


MESOLITHIC
8500-4000 BC

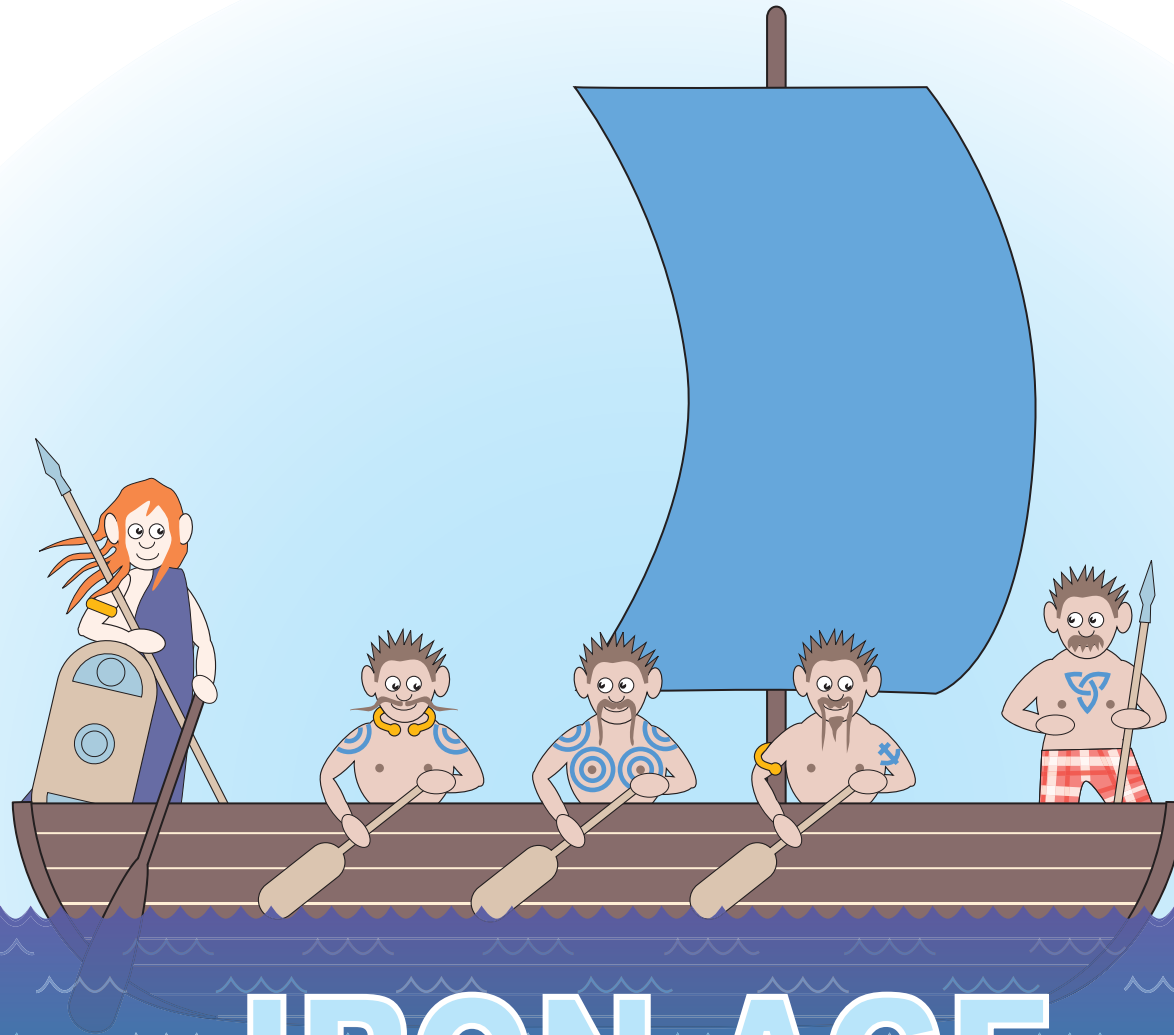


NEOLITHIC

4000-2400 BC

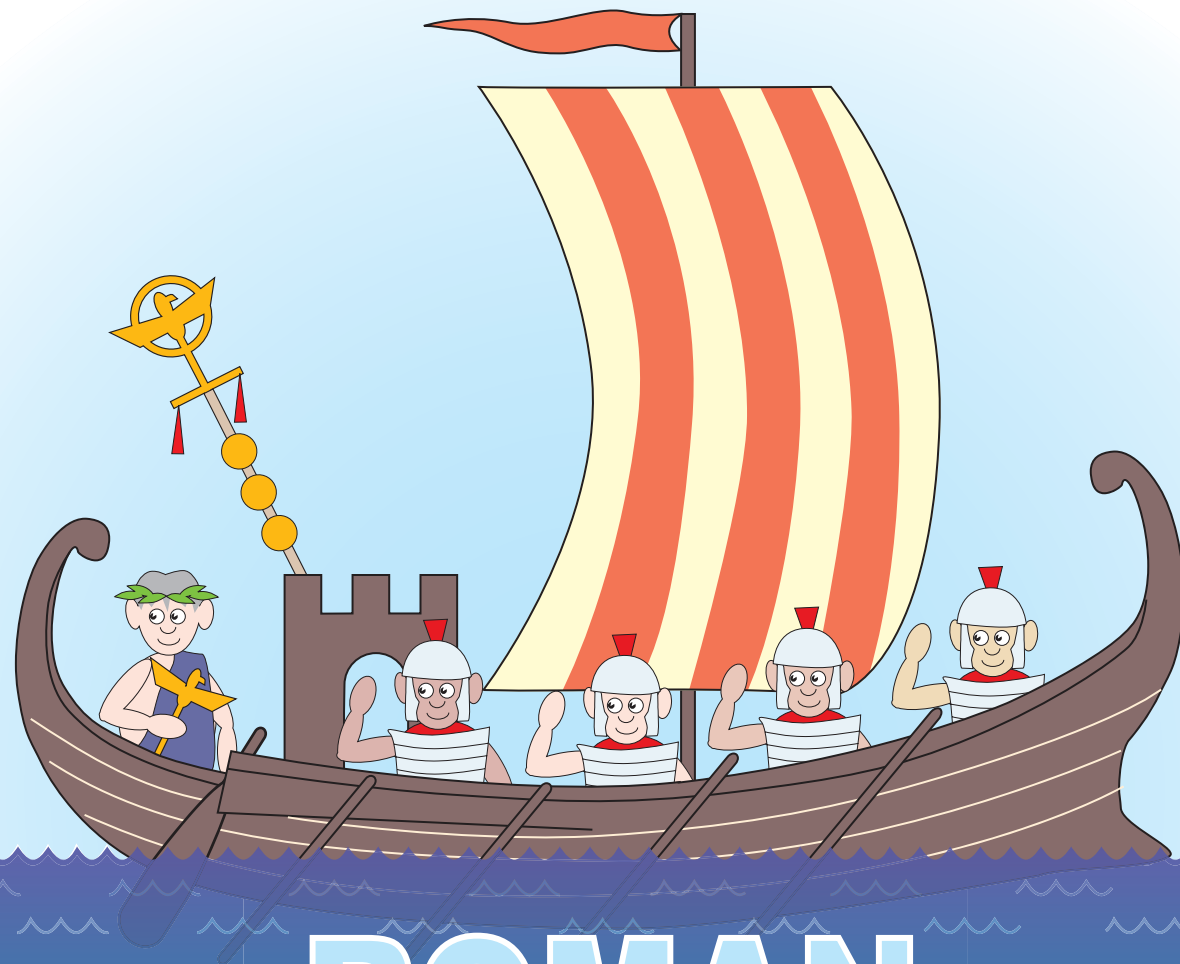


BRONZE AGE

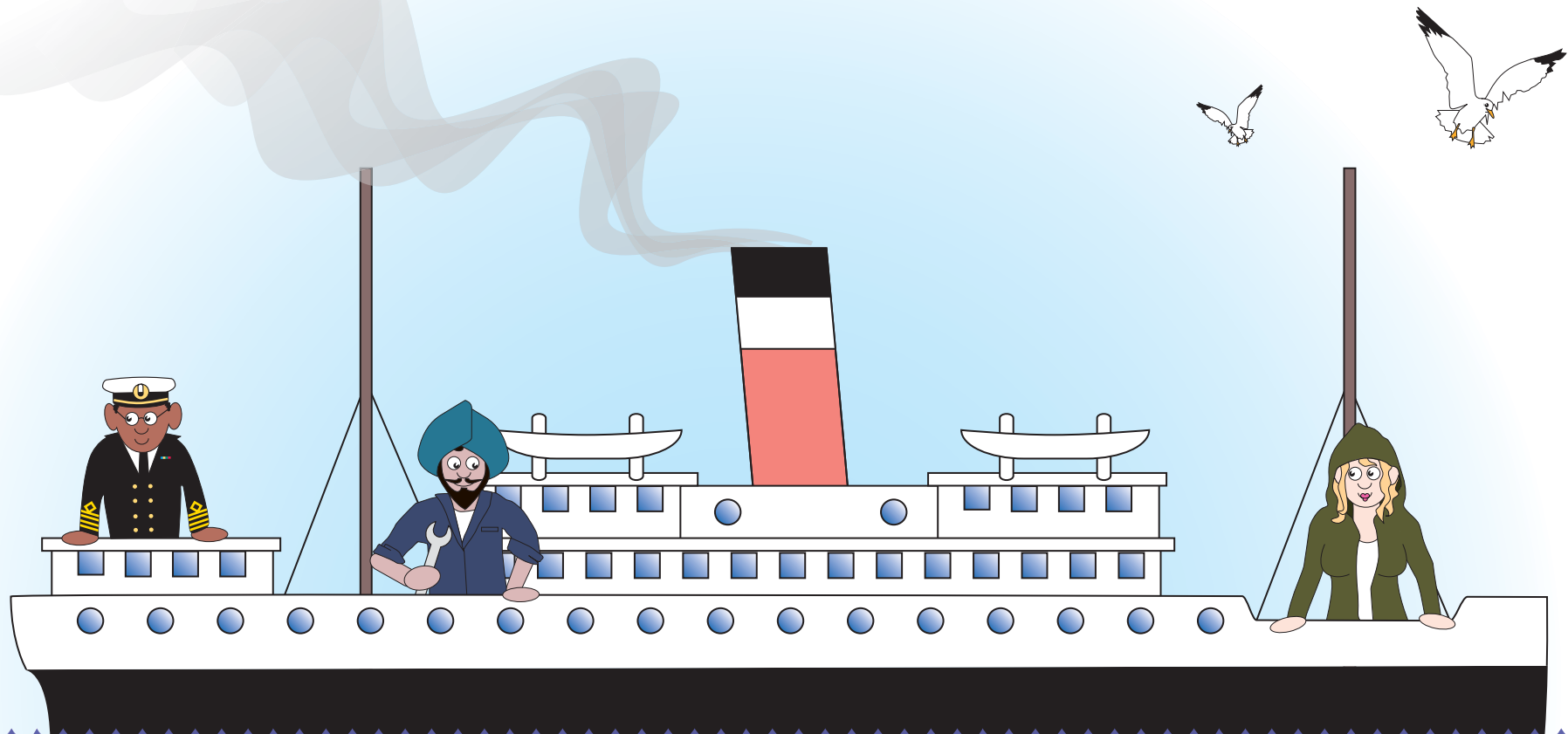


MEDIEVAL

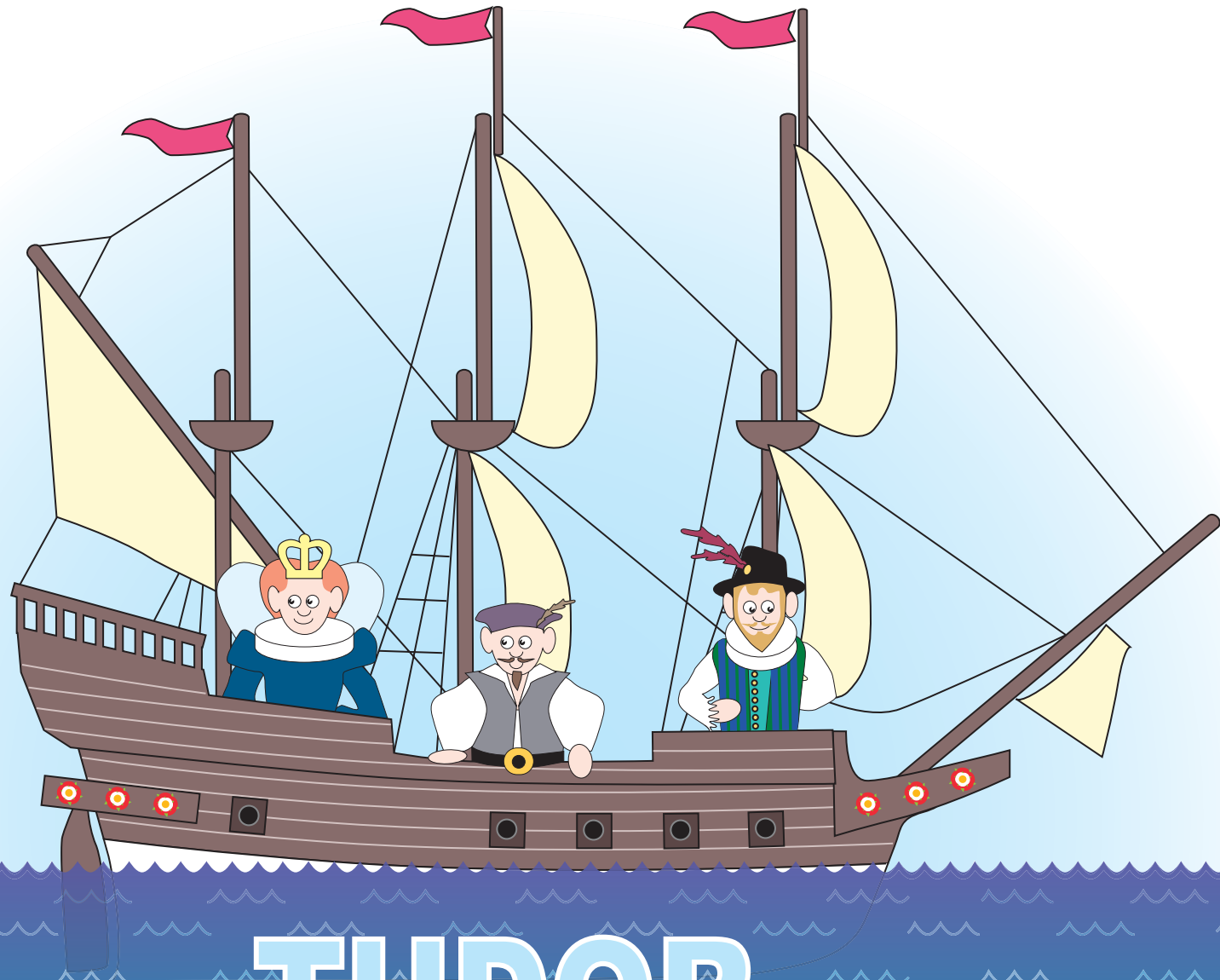


POST-MEDIEVAL 1500-1800 AD

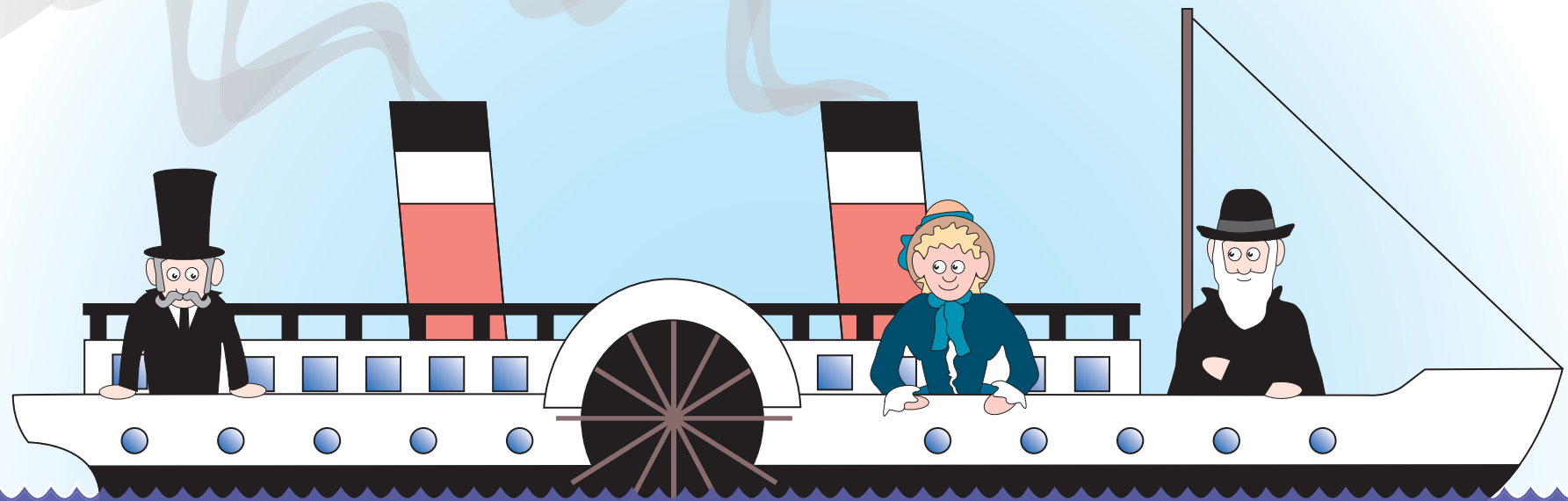
